




Use the QR Codes to hear exact arrangements we are using.

Assistance Program Update

Each week, families walk through our doors carrying different burdens — some are worried about how to keep the lights on, others are wondering how they'll put food on the table. Thanks to your generosity, Centenary's Assistance Program is able to meet those needs with both compassion and practical help.

In August, we provided 141 bags of food, feeding 307 people in our community. Each bag represents peace of mind for a parent and full bellies for children at the dinner table.

We also received 11 requests for financial assistance, and we were able to help with 8 of those, supporting 20 people with a total of \$1,139.90. That means rent was paid, utilities stayed on, and families were able to breathe a little easier.

One story that stands out this month is of a dad of three young children. Earlier this year, he lost his wife, and the grief of that loss has been compounded by the daily struggle of keeping up with expenses on a single income. When he fell behind on rent, Centenary was able to step in with assistance. That support helped him catch up and gave him the space to focus on caring for his children and rebuilding stability at home.

Every number tells a story of hope — and every story is possible because of you. Thank you for your faithful support, prayers, and giving that allow us to continue serving as the hands and feet of Christ in Shelby County.
