Assistance Program Update

Centenary's Assistance Ministry continues to be a powerful expression of God's love through the generosity of our church family. We are grateful to share an update on how your support has made a difference in recent months.

In November, Centenary received eight requests for financial assistance and was able to help six households, providing a total of \$887.80 in assistance. During the same month, we distributed 188 food bags, feeding 470 people. This total included 24 Christmas meal bags, made possible by your generosity. Of those Christmas meals, seven went directly to families connected to our church, while the remaining meals were shared with members of the wider community.

As we moved into December, financial assistance concluded on December 11 in preparation for the Christmas meal distributions. Prior to that date, we received three financial assistance applications and were able to assist two households, totaling \$249.56. One application could not be assisted due to other circumstances.

At the time of writing this article on December 17, we are in the midst of distributing our Christmas meal bags and have already handed out 170 food bags for December. With additional distributions still ahead, we anticipate that December will far surpass 200 food bags. A full update on Christmas meal distribution, along with a year-end summary of assistance provided in 2025, will be shared in January.

Looking ahead, we are excited to announce that in January, Centenary will begin offering in-person financial coaching classes as part of our assistance program. We will be hosting Operation Hope, and Trent Lloyd will be returning to lead these classes for individuals who may benefit from financial education and support.

As part of our assistance guidelines, individuals requesting financial assistance for a second time are referred to financial coaching and are required to complete a course before receiving further assistance. These in-person classes will fulfill that requirement while also equipping participants with valuable tools for long-term stability.

Thank you for continuing to be the hands and feet of Christ in our church and community. Your prayers, generosity, and support truly make a lasting impact.
